# Graduate and Family Housing Options





# Verano Place & Palo Verde

**Eligibility:** graduate students, law students, medical students (excluding interns and residents), single or with families; undergraduates with a spouse, domestic partner or children, or who are 25 years or older

- One-, two-, and three-bedroom unfurnished apartments (652 in Palo Verde; 852 in Verano); and a limited number of studios in Palo Verde
- Childcare programs are located in Verano Place (also open to Palo Verde residents)
- Utility costs vary. More information at housing.uci.edu/grad
- Located on the east side of the campus



#### **Campus Village**

Campus Village is an apartment community located in the campus core, next to the Science Library. Campus Village houses 384 single graduate students in two-bedroom apartments. Utility costs are included.

**Eligibility:** single students only – graduate students, law students, medical students (excluding interns and residents).

Campus Village offers two-bedroom unfurnished apartments with utilities included, except telephone.

#### Vista del Campo Vista del Campo Norte & Puerta del Sol

American Campus Communities (ACC) operates privatelyowned apartment communities on the east side of the UC Irvine campus.

**Eligibility:** graduate students, law students, medical students (single or married/domestic partners, without children)

Vista del Campo and Vista del Campo Norte offer one-, two-, and three-bedroom apartments. Puerta del Sol offers studios, efficiencies, and one-bedroom units. All apartments are furnished.

Utilities are included (with a monthly electricity allowance) in Vista del Campo and VDC Norte. In Puerta del Sol, electricity charges are separate.

#### **Off-Campus Housing**

# **Apply Online**

Newly-admitted students may apply for housing online beginning March 1, 2021.

- Submit your Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) as instructed by your academic program
- Then, apply for housing at housing.uci.edu

Fall housing assignments begin mid-May and continue throughout the summer.

IMPORTANT: Guaranteed students must apply by May 1, 2021 @ 4:00 p.m. and will receive a housing offer by July 31.

#### The Graduate Guarantee

UC Irvine guarantees an offer of on-campus housing to newly-admitted, full-time Fall 2020 Ph.D., M.F.A. and J.D. students who meet application, Statement of Intent to Register and fee payment deadlines.

Housing offers will be made for one of six graduate housing communities. Apartment offers are made throughout the summer and must be confirmed prior to the first day of classes. Guaranteed housing for Ph.D. students extends for one year less than normal time to degree (NTTD-1) for their academic program, and M.F.A. and J.D. students will be provided with housing for their academic programs' normal times to degree, up to three years (NTTD).

Graduate students who are not eligible for the guarantee may apply to be placed on the housing waitlist. Housing offers will be made as space becomes available.

Students who are eligible service members, reservists, and veterans are guaranteed an offer of on-campus housing. Contact UCI Veteran Services for information: veteran.uci.edu.

# **Campus Services**

#### **Childcare Services**

UCI Child Care Services operates a number of programs serving the children of UCI students, faculty and staff. Five child care centers are located in Verano Place.

Verano Place also operates an after-school program and a 10-week summer program for school-age children. More information at housing.uci.edu/grad.

Students interested in obtaining childcare should apply early due to high demand and lengthy wait-lists.

## **Transportation** On and Off Campus

Free on-campus shuttle buses operated by Associated Students of UCI (ASUCI) run Monday through Friday during the academic year.

University Pass (U-Pass) gives students lowcost unlimited access to the Orange County Transportation Authority's (OCTA) extensive bus system 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Car rentals by the day or by the hour are offered through the Zipcar program.

The ZotWheels bikeshare program offers low-cost access to bicycles for getting around campus.
