



## Our Communities

UCI offers a wide range of apartment options for graduate students and families. Floor plans, rental rates, and utilities vary by location. Contract start dates are continuous throughout the summer, based on unit availability. UCI Student Housing apartments are unfurnished. Each community offers indoor and outdoor recreation facilities.

### Campus Village

Located in the campus core, adjacent to the Science Library, Campus Village consists of 197 2-bedroom apartments. A fitness center, recreation room, and small movie theater are located in the community.

### Verano Place

Located on the east campus, Verano Place consists of 852 1-, 2-, and 3-bedroom units. UCI Child Care facilities and a community garden are located in the community.

### Palo Verde

Located on the east campus, Palo Verde consists of 652 1-, 2-, and 3-bedroom units. A family resource center and community garden are located in the community.

### Verano Towers

Opened in August 2022, Verano Towers added 425 apartments (in 5 buildings) to the Verano Place community, including studio, 2- and 4-bedroom units.

*Family housing for students with children is offered in Verano Place and Palo Verde.*

## American Campus Communities (ACC)

American Campus Communities operates privately-owned apartment communities on the east side of the UCI campus. All apartments are furnished and provide air conditioning, cable TV and Internet access and have fixed lease start dates that vary by community. - **Vista del Campo and Vista del Campo Norte** offer 1-, 2-, and 3-bedroom units with mostly mid-September lease start dates.
- **Puerta del Sol** offers studios, efficiencies, and one-bedroom units with an early-August lease start.
- **Plaza Verde** offers 1-, 2-, and 4-bedroom units with a mid-September lease start. (Most 2- and 4-bedroom units are occupied by undergraduates.)

## Apply Online

Newly-admitted students may apply for housing online beginning March 1, 2023.

- 1 Submit your Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) as instructed by your academic program. (Submit your SIR at least 48 hours before the housing application deadline.)
- 2 Then, apply for housing at [housing.uci.edu](http://housing.uci.edu)

Housing offers begin mid-May and continue throughout the summer.

**IMPORTANT: Guaranteed students must apply by May 2, 2023 @ 4:00 p.m. and will receive a housing offer by July 31.**

## The Graduate Guarantee

UC Irvine guarantees an offer of on-campus housing to newly-admitted, full-time Fall 2023 Ph.D., M.F.A. and J.D. students who meet application, Statement of Intent to Register and fee payment deadlines.

Housing offers will be made for one of seven graduate housing communities. Apartment offers are made throughout the summer and students must move in prior to the first day of classes. Guaranteed housing for eligible students extends for the normal time to degree (NTTD) of their academic program.

Graduate students who are not eligible for the guarantee may apply to be placed on the housing waitlist. Housing offers will be made as space becomes available.

Students who are eligible service members, reservists, and veterans are guaranteed an offer of on-campus housing. Contact UCI Veteran Services for information: [veteran.uci.edu](http://veteran.uci.edu).

# Campus Services

## Child Care Services

## Transportation On and Off Campus

Free on-campus shuttle buses operated by Associated Students of UCI (ASUCI) run Monday through Friday during the academic year.

University Pass (U-Pass) gives students low-cost unlimited access to the Orange County Transportation Authority's (OCTA) extensive bus system 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Car rentals by the day or by the hour are offered through the Zipcar program.
